Review of current COVID-19 situation

- 144 cases (Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Clear Creek, Denver, Douglas, Eagle, El Paso, Garfield, Gunnison, Jefferson, Larimer, Mesa, Pitkin, Pueblo, Routt, Summit, Weld)
- Community transmission likely: Denver metro, Eagle, Gunnison, Pitkin, Summit
- Hospitalized: 20Outcome: 1 death

NEW LPHAs: track all staff time for COVID-19 response efforts
