John Piquette, Finance Officer, met with the BOCC regarding the budget. He still needs to find \$40,500 in order to balance the budget. After much discussion, it was decided to increase landfill fees to \$7.00/cubic yard for commercial use and \$9.00/cubic yard for public use, with .25 cents/yard going towards a recycling program. Tires will increase \$1.00 per tire.

Commissioner Shy made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Custer, to put .25 cents/cubic yard that is collected at the landfill towards a recycling program. Motion carried unanimously.

Dawna Hobby, Human Resource and Finance Manager, met with the BOCC to give her monthly report.

The BOCC would like a letter sent to the Custer County Livestock Club stating that both the 4-H and FFA programs were no longer making premises ID mandatory and that the Animal Care and Housing Form that goes along with 4-H enrollment has been modified to protect confidentiality. The club also needs to provide proof of insurance and have a background check done on their leaders. Any other issues involving the showing or selling of animals must be taken up with the Custer County Fair Board and/or Sale Committee.

Virginia Trujillo, County Treasurer, gave her monthly report to the BOCC.

Laura Lockhart, Social Services Director, gave her monthly report to the BOCC.
