# **NEW AND OLD BUSINESS**

## **NOVEMBER BOCC MEETINGS**

County Clerk and Recorder, Kelley Camper, informed the board that there is a BOCC meeting scheduled on November 7<sup>th</sup>, which is also Election Day. She stated that in the past, they haven't held BOCC meetings on Election Day. After discussion, the board decided that because of election activities, it would be best to change the November 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, and 15<sup>th</sup> BOCC meetings.

MOTION by Commissioner Kattnig, to change the November 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> BOCC meetings to November 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motion carried unanimously.

MOTION by Commissioner Printz, to change the November 16<sup>th</sup> BOCC meeting to November 22<sup>nd</sup>. Motion carried unanimously.

#### MARIJUANA GRANT

Undersheriff, Chris Barr, met with the board to inform them about a marijuana grant in the amount of \$4,823.50 that he has applied for through the Department of Local Affairs (DOLA). This grant doesn't require matching funds. The grant money will be used to reimburse man hours spent during the investigation of illegal marijuana grows in the county, and for the purchase of a storage container that was purchased for marijuana storage.

MOTION by Commissioner Kattnig, to write a letter supporting the Sheriff's Department initiative for a DOLA grant for reimbursement of marijuana expenses. Motion carried unanimously.

#### COUNTY HEALTH INSURANCE RENEWAL

BOCC Administrative Assistant, Brenda Gaide, had previously sent the board a spread sheet with the bids she had received for the county health insurance. After discussion, the board decided that the best plan for 2017 was with Colorado Technical Services, Inc. (CTSI). The change in carriers will save the county approximately \$50,000.

MOTION by Commissioner Hood, to select CTSI as the new insurance carrier. Motion carried unanimously.
